- Our next meeting will be at Aeromark so we need to a call-around to get all the members out, particularly since we will be taking nominations for at least one new board member. Call-around assignments were made.
- Discussed the “cookies” engraved on our field by a vandal pickup recently. Apparently the driver is a teenager named Otley. This should be reported to the Sheriffs Office since at least three sprinkler heads were damaged. Lee Powell knows the people at the start of our road that reported this occurrence.
- Loren Marler’s son Chris, an Eagle Scout, will undertake the fence installation on the south boundary as a public works project for the Scouts. This is a great break.
- The County still needs to get the fence line surveyed. Walter will check with Keven Eckersel on this matter.
- There have been a couple of inquiries from possible members as a result of the Tri-Club meet.
- Talked about the Alpine meet and some of the events.
- Don talked about membership and said that Brent Belnap’s proposed RC Hobbies course (emphasis airplanes) at ETIC has been approved. It is scheduled for an April start, Wednesday’s and Thursday’s, 2-hour sessions, 6-weeks in length. We will furnish all the support needed by Brent. Perhaps Elliot could do the part on helicopters?
- Over heating of the pump: We need to get the radiator professionally cleaned. Steve will get this done at Radiator King for estimated cost of \$140.
- The Tri-club event took in about \$646 and we have bills for about \$700, so we broke about even. Steve gave our treasury amount at about \$1056. Walter will call to stop mowing unless we call for it.
- Our lease payment needs to go to the Road and Bridge Department rather than the County Commissioners so that the money gets into the correct account.
