

**Desert Eagles Model Airplane Flying Club**  
**Meeting Minutes 01/08/2007 @ 7:30 PM**  
**Location: Aeromark**

- Walter Grasmick, Steve Henderson, and Russ Crawford were the board members present. Seventeen other members also attended the meeting.
- Walter opened the meeting stating that the new newsletter by Brent Belnap is posted on our website. It is about 37 megabytes because of the pictures included. and was proofread by Walter's daughter.
- Steve presented a financial report for 2006. \$1020 in the checking account and \$1200 in a CD. Expenses for the year were \$975 for lawn mowing, \$370 for irrigation pump fuel and \$160 for maintenance of the irrigation system.
- A \$50 Texas Roadhouse gift certificate was purchased and presented to Bob Hoft in appreciation for use of the Aeromark conference room.
- Current expenses due are \$400 to the County for our field lease and about \$100 to the AMA for our club charter.
- Al Tucker stated that there will be indoor flying at Tailorview on the next two Sundays, then two Sundays off, and then fly again the following Sunday.
- Talked about the IRS form needed by the INL. Walter is meeting with his CPA about our non-profit status.
- Brent Belnap talked about the newsletter. It has a contest identifying cockpit pictures and also some 10% off coupons from Dapco and Leptron. Brent needs support from club members. Needed are pictures, articles, building tips, etc.
- Bon Brooks is selling a powered glider that needs some repairs and a Cessna 172 kit with 72-in wingspan that will need a one cu. in. engine.
- If you fly every month of the year and keep a log with witness signatures, you can get a patch from the AMA.
- Walter showed us a ducted-fan electric flying wing model that he has completed but not flown yet. It came from Tower Hobbies for about \$100 and only needed an ESC, receiver, servos and battery. There is some space management skill needed to assemble all the equipment under the canopy.
- Brent showed us some neat sanding and shaping tools, etc., that are very useful for building planes.
- Walter closed the meeting about 8:30
