- ! Steve reported our bank balance at about \$2063. We have about 36 members now. Six new members signed up tonight. One bid received for field mowing for \$1250. Gas will cost about \$500. So our treasury is nearly fully committed with little contingency funds for repairs, etc.

- ! We need to tell the neighboring farmer that our new fence is being installed on the south property line so that he doesn't waste any seed in planting on our side. Steve will call Lee Powell for farmer contact information.
